A Message from the Foundation

Dear Families, Friends and Supporters of CSMH,

With this 2017-2018 Annual Report, the Charter School of Morgan Hill Foundation is celebrating six years of serving the students of CSMH. While the Foundation's primary focus is to raise funds, we also believe that we are constantly "Enriching the Heart of CSMH." Of course, this heart being the students, staff, parents, project-based learning philosophy, and the positive school culture.

Your generosity has allowed CSMH students to participate in multiple field trips, including the eighth grade Pennsylvania/Washington DC experience. Class supplies are provided that facilitate learning in the classroom and support project-based learning. Facilities improvements have been made possible and scholarships have been granted to recognize the success of our alumni graduating from high school and embarking on their next educational pursuit.

We are proud to have expanded our support by being able to recognize our incredible teachers, support staff and administrative team, all of whom play a key role in student success. In October 2017, in an effort to acknowledge the long-term commitment of the CSMH staff, the School developed a Service Appreciation Award Program to reward 10, 15 and 20 years of service at CSMH. In the 2017-2018 year, CSMH had eighteen staff members who had served the School for 10 or more years. The Foundation provided the large initial payment needed to implement this program and remains committed to fund future awards during the early phases of this program.

During this year, your donations allowed the Foundation to make \$356,000 in grants to CSMH. These grants included the amount for the Service Appreciation Awards, funds raised in 2016 for the track, plus ongoing support for class supplies and field trips. In addition, the "Make it Happen" fundraiser at the Boots and Bling Gala in October 2017 raised \$48,000 which is being held in reserve for an Ag Learning Center to enhance our amazing agriculture program.

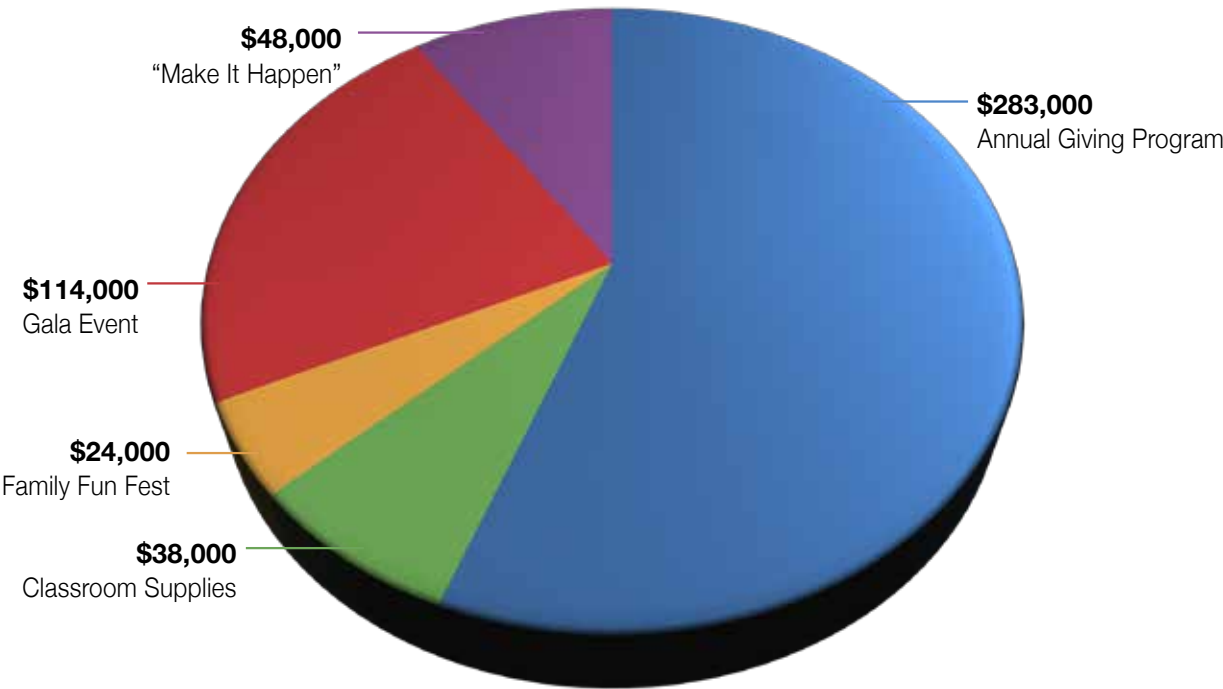

Enhancing the Resources

Financial Results

The generous CSMH community continued to support the School with donations through the Annual Giving Program, Class Supplies Fund Drive, the Gala and the Family Fun Festival. Net fundraising income of \$507,000 was raised during the year. Some of this amount has been reserved for future years (Class Supplies for 2018-2019 of \$23,000 and Donations to the future Ag Learning Center of \$48,000) while the balance of these donations allowed the Foundation to provide \$356,000 in grants to CSMH during the 2017-2018 school year.

Net Fundraising 2017-2018

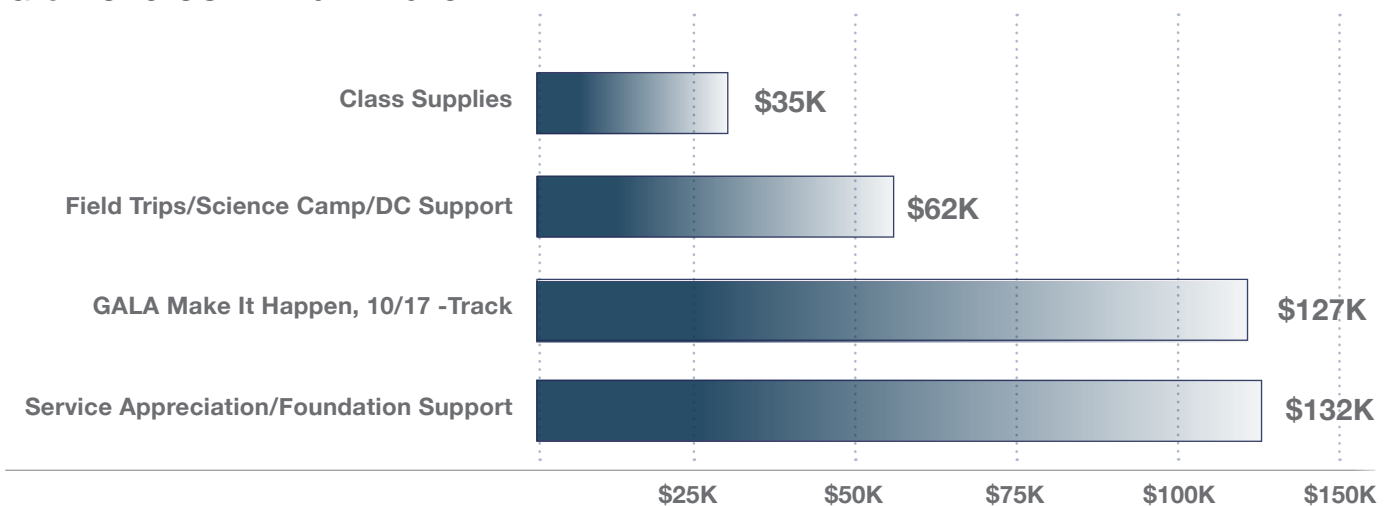

The ultimate goal of the Foundation is to spearhead fundraising efforts for CSMH to provide the School with resources to achieve its mission. Class supplies and field trip grants are ongoing commitments by the Foundation. Going forward we have also pledged to support the Service Appreciation Award Program to ensure CSMH is able to recruit and retain the high quality teachers that have led to the School's dramatic success over the years. Specific goals identified by CSMH, such as the track, often take longer to realize. Preliminary funds raised for the track were donated at the 2016 Make it Happen and were supplemented in 2017-2018. The total of \$356,000 in grants during 2017-2018 is a record so far, achieved only as a result of the generosity of our families, friends and community supporters.

Annual Giving (July 2017 - June 2018)

The financial support of our donors enriches the programs offered by CSMH in so many ways. During the July 2017 – June 2018 school year, generous cash donations to the Annual Giving Program, Classroom Supplies Fundraiser, Gala Make it Happen Campaign, and Gala and Family Fun Fest Sponsorships exceeded \$336,000.
