HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Scholarship Application - Due April 5, 2021

To qualify for the CSMH Foundation High School Scholarship:

- Students must have attended CSMH for a minimum of 1 year.
- Students must currently be a high school senior.
- Students must be planning on pursuing a college education or entering into a trade school. Monies must be used for school related expenses.
- Eligible students must submit a transcript reflecting a 3.0 cumulative GPA, a copy is acceptable.
- Eligible students will be active in sports, leadership, community groups or any other intra or extra-curricular activity.
- *Students who are related to current or past CSMH staff or board members, or current or past CSMH Foundation board members will not be eligible for the scholarship.*
